

Season 2022 for the Waverley Park Hawks Under 11's side can only be described as successful. Encouragement, kindness, team work and respect were the values our players identified as important to them as we set out on the 2022 season. And that is what we got – on and off the field. Bringing two groups together – half the team moving up from U12s and the other half playing in their second season of U14s – can be tricky. But the players quickly gelled into a close-knit unit at training and on game day.

Their teamwork often proved the difference, stringing together impressive passages of play that saw the ball moved end to end along the wings or boldly through the middle. There were one percenters: tackles, bumps and shepherds that freed up a teammate. And there were wonderful celebrations after a goal.

Our mid-fielders were the engine room that got things going, while the back line was resolute and the forwards added the finishing touches.

Ruck duties were mostly shared between Daisy Robinson, Eliza Klein and Zoe Wright who all at various times turned games our way with exceptional tap work and follow-up around the ground, including slotting more than a few goals. Ball magnets Jade Gundry and Ebony Stevenson were mainstays in the midfield. This dynamic duo were at every contest, head down winning the hard ball or putting on a tackle to stop the opposition in their tracks. The equally tough and silky skilled Suzie Alexiou regularly chipped in to rove the centre bounces when she was not causing havoc for the opposition high on the forward line or on the wing.

Our speedsters – Julia Hipwell, Olivia Snart, Scarlett Moresi and Shiloh Jenkins – provided crucial run between defence and attack, their versatility meaning they were often call upon to perform important roles all over the ground. Shiloh was a newcomer to football this season but fitted in like a seasoned pro. Also welcomed into our back line were Jamie Eva, with her steady hands and close checking, and Claudia Blangiardo, with her exceptional game sense. With Claudia holding down full-back, Bella Cruize Appelman and Zoe (when she wasn't rucking) were freed up to play across the half-back line, cutting off countless opposition forays and pumping the ball back to our advantage. When the opposition did get some penetration into their forward line, our support team of Heather Cassidy, Layla Christian and Paige Bretherton worked their hearts out to win back possession and run or boot the ball back out of there. Layla in particular was great at keeping an eye on the goal line and dropping back to lend a hand on the last line of defence.

Heather, whose confidence to back herself soared during the season, also did some great work on the wing, while Paige got on the end of a bag of goals during the season when switched into the forward line. Kinslie Vicic was another of our goal sneaks, regularly bobbing up to slot one through when the opposition least expected it, using her astute reading of the play to put herself in just the right position.

Another of our regular forwards Georgia Simpson not only showed her worth by kicking goals but also with her pressure to keep the ball locked in our forward line. This pressure saw her help out across the half-back line to great effect late in the season.

Bianca Hooper-Ford really developed into her full-forward role as the season progressed, providing another strong target and crucial forward pressure, while Bella made the occasional classy cameo in the forward line, including to kick a bag of three and four in two games.

Structures and positioning were a key focus at training throughout the season and it was really rewarding to see the players executing this on the field, setting up defensive lines to keep the ball in our forward half, anticipating the play and making position for the next kick or handball.

It was also wonderful to see some natural leaders emerge among the group, with Eliza and Daisy in particular leading the way with their actions and encouragement and guidance of teammates on the field.

Our season came to an end with a narrow loss in a prelim final. Although heartbreaking for the players, this was a huge achievement in a season that threw more than a couple of challenges our way. Congratulations everyone.

BLADES OF GLORY UNDER 17.5 FOALE COACH'S REPORT

2022 Div 2 Premiers! What a year it has been for the Blades of Glory U17.5 Foale team, an amazing way for a lot of our boys to complete their junior football journey and their time with the Hawks.

The season began at the start of February with an intense pre-season program, which included all the senior boys from the club from U14 to U17, with 2 conditioning sessions each week in the summer heat, running and strength activities with a little bit of fun (some great tug of war battles). At that point, we had around 30 players registered, and were undecided if we could secure the extra numbers to get 2 teams in the age group. All the boys reached out to a lot of their former teammates, and put the squeeze on, and by the end of March, we had over 40 boys in the age group and were able to field 2 teams in separate divisions.

Our journey began with a combined u17.5 squad in the traditional Rovers practise match, which was a great opportunity for some friendly competition and banter between both clubs, it was a spirited fast game where the Rovers came out on top. Our squad was then finalised, and we began our season in Division 2 with losses in our first 2 grading games, however, more importantly we also lost Harper Vicic to a season ending Knee injury. The boys rallied for Harps, and we found some form in the next 2 grading games with big margin wins over Bentleigh and East Brighton Caulfield which secured our position in the division 2 league. Both wins were achieved by relentless pressure and exceptional transitional ball movement. Harper was consequently elevated from the injury list to take on the assistant coaching role, and he led the boys to a big win in round 5 against Murrumbeena, who had beaten team McCluskey the week prior in division 3. Unfortunately, we got hit with further injuries throughout that period, losing Brady Pensa, Sebastian Schenk and Patt Bunning for extended periods, our squad of 23 was down to only 20 fit players. Compounding our challenge was the promotion of Connor Riley into the Oakleigh Chargers Nab league squad, ruling him ineligible to play for the Hawks for a number of games, it was awesome for Connor's football development and a highlight for the boys to see a well-loved teammate running around in the Nab league.

The next stage of the season wasn't great for the boys, with the losses to player numbers, we were fronting up to games with only 16 players, often relying on players from other age groups, or from Team McCluskey, to fill in to ensure we avoided forfeits. Despite playing with the right intent, and working hard, we lost the next 4 in a row, to fall from 2nd, to bottom of the ladder and put our season in doubt.

Over the extended school holiday and bye round break, we regrouped, our boys reached out to a number of retired players, to strengthen our numbers, allowing us to have a bench again, which became a valuable asset. We were able to rotate players, and we had options for opposition match ups and changes in games. As injured players started to return, our form improved, and we managed to go undefeated through the back half of the season to secure a finals spot finishing 3rd on the ladder.

The finals series has been one to remember for the boys, 5 goals down in an elimination final against Caulfield East Brighton, we rallied, got the lead, only to give it up with 3 minutes left, we then scored the last 2 points of the match to secure a 1 point victory. Onto the prelim final, where we jumped Mordi Brae (the only team we hadn't beaten all year), getting out to an early 3 goal lead, the game then swung with the breeze and mordi brae had the lead at halftime. We played a blistering 3rd qtr, to take a 2 score lead into the last change, kicking into the breeze in the last quarter. Mordi Brae had the running early, and our defence was under pressure however they were standing up, Mordi eventually wrenched the lead from us, and we trailed by 3 points with about 2 minutes on the clock. Then after a continuous bombardment into our forward half, and an amazing 5 bounce run down the wing by Luke Camerotto, Pat Warr took a screamer of a pack mark, and duly slotted the major from 25m, with 10 seconds to go and send us into the Grand final with a 3 point win.

The big dance was an outstanding display of team football, from the very first bounce. The boys dominated general play and the pressure we applied was extraordinary, and it was just too much for Bentleigh to handle. We outworked them on and off the ball, and capitalised on our opportunities, despite a last quarter challenge, we ran out comfortable winners by 28 points to claim the division 2 premiership.

Through this journey, we have made lifelong bonds and memories that we can all share for years to come. It's been a privilege to coach at the Hawks and be involved with this group of young men as far back for some as their first season of under 9's. Good luck to all the boys, wherever their football journey takes them, thanks for the ride.
