















LIFE MEMBERS

Season 2023 was my 4th year in a row having the privilege of coaching this outstanding group of young men. We started training a little earlier this year, commencing at the beginning of February, and added Thursday night sessions to our week. The boys were committed from the start and adapted to 2 nights per week well for the first team in their footy playing days.

This year we nominated Captains for the season for the first time. The Captains were voted for by their teammates; Cooper Austin was voted team Captain, Xavier Kelly and Emre Soydan were both voted joint Vice-Captains. All three Captains showed strong leadership at training and lead from the front on match days.

Moving into the season we found ourselves one division higher than previous years, in Division 3, and discovered that there was a big jump in physical size and skill level of our opponents.

It took us a number of rounds to adjust to these challenges. In the second half of the season we enjoyed 2 wins, pushed the top 4 teams to within 2 goals and enjoyed the individual improvement of a number of our players.

It's a huge credit to our group for showing a great deal of resilience and perseverance to never throw the towel in and continue to compete at their hardest each week. Our team has always shown great spirit to rarely go down without a fight. We are an excellent tackling side, our boys listen to instructions very well, we play hard but fair and kept working to improve our game plan and our skills.

Some of our improvement was shown by the players understanding they needed to be accountable for their opponent, the midfielders understanding that they needed to keep up with the play and get to most contests, and the importance of holding our positions; not ball following and getting sucked up to every contest. We learnt the importance of always contesting the aerial ball, even if we're caught out of position. We also improved over the season using our bodies to gain an advantage in the contest.

Individual improvements came from the likes of Riley Mastromanno, who has developed into one of the more dominant ruck players in our division. The improvement of his foot skills and decision making was huge over the course of the season. George Fatouros had a break-out season on the wing and Matteo Spada became a real asset in the backline, getting to more contests and showing great courage. Both of these boys learnt to make smart decisions with their disposals.

Christian Di Somma found his place on the wing during the year and earnt himself a game in the midfield for our final round game. It was a stand out performance that not only helped us to victory but should also lead to him playing more of his footy there in the future.

Tyce Corcoran made his footy debut this year and made an instant impact to our side. He has a bright future as a centre-half forward/ruck player. Ethan Trumble's second half of the season was excellent as he played an in-and-under role in the mid-field, putting his body on the line to earn the footy for his team.
